Supported Housing Scheme

Supported housing is accommodation for people who are aged 60 and over, who can live on their own but who would like to have support close by.

We have 33 supported housing schemes across Dacorum with a range of self-contained flats and bungalows. Social gatherings and activities are often available within these schemes.

Saturn Way in Highfield, Hemel Hempstead is a purpose built supported scheme.

Where is Saturn Way?

Saturn Way is in Highfield, Hemel Hempstead, close to bus stops on Ellingham Road which provide easy access to Hemel Hempstead Town Centre. It's half a mile from The Queens Square where there are shops, a chemist and cafes. The nearest doctors' surgery is Everest House, which is less than 15 minutes' walk away.

How many flats are there?

There are 10 flats in the scheme managed by Dacorum Borough Council, there are also two flats managed by Hertfordshire County Council. all in small blocks of four or six flats across two floors.

What facilities are there?

There is a communal lounge and a laundry for tenants to use. There is a guest room which can be booked for overnight visitors and a car park for tenants' cars.

What activities do other tenants participate in?

This scheme has a coffee morning each week. The tenants often organise fish and chip lunches and barbecues as well as day trips and special events. We also run tablet courses to

help tenants get online as part of our **Tenant Academy**, and a range of other free courses are available.
